

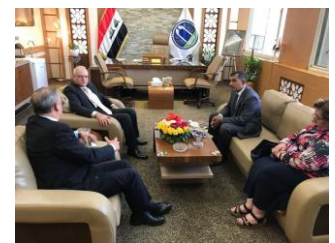
President of University of Baghdad receives the students of engineering coming back from Australia

President of University of Baghdad, Prof. Dr. Alaa Abdul Hussein Abdul Rasool and in the presence of the administrative undersecretary of the ministry of higher education and scientific research, Prof. Dr. Mohammed Attiya al-Sarraaj received a number of the students of the college of engineering who represent the second group that completed their elementary studies at University of Sam Bourne in Australia within the twinning program between the two sides. Prof. Dr. Alaa Abdul Rasool stressed that this stage should be the beginning of the real departure for these students towards the service of Iraq and the labor market through the embodiment of all that was gained from science and knowledge and made it accessible to all students who did not have the opportunity to complete their studies abroad.
