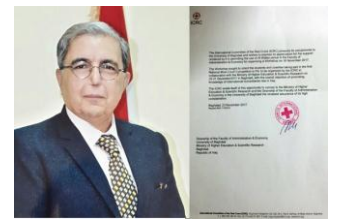
Ibn al-Haitham College of education holds the 1st international scientific conference

Morning and afternoon sessions were also launched to discuss six joint researches per session as well as discussing research from outside Iraq. Then the closing session was held in the presence of participants from inside and outside Iraq who were awarded the shield of the college and certificates of appreciation for their sober academic efforts.

His Excellency, the minister of higher education and scientific research, Prof. Dr. Abdul Razaq al-Issa, signed with his Turkish counterpart and president of the Turkish Higher Education Commission, Dr. Mohammed Yakta Siraj a joint scientific memorandum of understanding for the sake of implementation of the agreements concluded this year between the two parties as well as promotion of the teaching of the Turkish language in the college of languages in Iraq.
