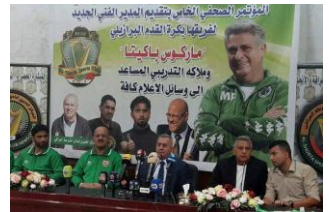


## College of physical education hosts the Brazilian coach of Police Football Team
